The American Legion is a great organization for veterans and military members to find fellowship, feel supported for their love of our great country and, best of all, continue serving their community on a local and national level. In addition, a membership in the Legion opens the door to many discount programs at various businesses and entertainment venues.

Membership in The American Legion is based on a calend January 1st to December 31st. When we pay our dues, up for that membership year. The renewal process begin

Membership in The American Legion is based on a calendar-year from January 1st to December 31st. When we pay our dues, we are paid up for that membership year. The renewal process begins in July for the upcoming membership year. Renewal notices are sent out in July, October, January, March and May. When a member renews, they are removed from future renewal notices for that year. There are times when a member pays their dues, but they still receive a renewal notice. If dues are paid to the local post, it takes a little longer for national to be notified about the renewal and the member may receive another renewal notice. If this should happen, please contact one of the officers so we can check on your status.

Where do dues go? A percentage goes to state and national levels of the American Legion to pay for many programs benefiting veterans returning home, military families in need, as well as, our youth. These funds also support Department Service Officers helping veterans who assist veterans in preparing claims and obtaining their full military healthcare benefits through the VA. Another percentage stays at the post level benefiting the similar programs specific to the local community. Some of these include Boys and Girls State; educational materials for our local schools, Oratorical Contests and other youth programs.

Up to now, dues have been only 35 dollars per year. The American Legion's National Executive Committee is currently proposing to raise the dues by 5 dollars at the beginning of 2016. The NEC's recommendation comes at a time when the need for American Legion advocacy, expertise, influence, services and programs are sorely needed in every corner of our nation. Veterans are waiting too long for benefit claim decisions and medical appointments. They need well-trained accredited American Legion service officers right now and for years to A national \$5 per-capita dues increase can prevent National Headquarters from having to cut programs and services over the course of an entire decade.



We anticipate getting the final word on their decision after the Legion's National Convention scheduled at the end of this month. In the meantime, I would like to mention that we are able to renew our memberships not only on an annual basis, but also on a five-year or a life-time one at the current rates.

The big ride in August was the annual Legacy Run. The American Legion Legacy Run traveled the open roads and highways along some of the most scenic areas of the United States. Portions included the Ohio River, historic towns and cities, farmlands, two-lane roads and interstate, and beautiful plains, hills and rivers of Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Maryland. Highlights of Legacy Run 2015 included shorter days, shorter legs, several stops at military and veteran memorials, wreath laying ceremonies (each day), meals at American Legion Posts, a return visit to Stoystown, PA and the Flight 93 Memorial, and a three-hour layover at Gettysburg National Battlefield. This run funds and promotes the Legacy scholarship which provides college scholarships for children of active duty United States military and National Guard, and military reservists who were federalized and die on active duty on or after September 11, 2001.

#### **Post 43 Annual Dues Programs**

With the conclusion of the Department of Illinois Convention, the New Legion Year commences. That's right, the officers elected in May have officially begun their duties as officers even though the formal installation will be postponed until our first Dinner/Social in September. The first half of the year (August - December) is also the time for our annual membership drive. It would certainly be nice to complete our membership drive by December rather than May, the end of the year. Check out what group you belong to and re-up. We need each and every

one of you.

Naperville Post 43 "Paid up for Life" Program: This is a special program designed to pay the annual dues for members that live in the Naperville area, have been a member of Post 43 for at least a year and served during WW II (Dec. 7<sup>th</sup>, 1941-Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>, 1946). This same privilege applies to those that served during the Korean War Era (Jun. 25<sup>th</sup>, 1950-Jan. 31<sup>st</sup>, 1955). We also pay the annual dues for any member of American Legion Post 43 who has been a member of the American Legion for 50 years or more.

Active Duty, including Active National Guard and Reserves: Post 43 will pay the annual dues of any member serving full time on Active Duty regardless of branch or location served and for those Active Guardsmen/Reservists that attend monthly drills and are subject to activation. But, they must want to become a member of the American Legion Post 43 and be from Naperville.

<u>Hardship Cases:</u> In the event a current Post 43 member is experiencing a personal "hardship", Post 43 will pay their annual dues as long as this situation continues and he/she resides in the Naperville area.

<u>Annual Membership Dues:</u> This is the most widely used Program for active dues paying members. Current annual dues are \$35.

<u>Department of Illinois 5 year Gold card:</u> Now through December 1, 2015 you can get a five year membership for just \$130.00. If you have already paid your \$35.00 for 2016 then you only need to submit an additional \$105.00 to Post 43 and you will be paid through 2020.

American Legions Paid up for Life (PUFL): This program is the National American Legion Program where members can pay for a "Life Membership" in the American Legion and is based on age and the annual cost of dues for the Post.


